Program: "To Conserve and Preserve" Cleveland Metroparks History 101. An entertaining history of the beginnings and growth of Cleveland Metroparks from its inception in the early 1900s to its current status as the much loved "Emerald Necklace" of Northeast Ohio. Cleveland Metroparks is an extensive system of nature preserves that generally follow rivers and creeks that flow through the region. The park spans over 21,500 acres and provides walking, bicycling and horse trails, picnic areas, nature centers, golf courses, fishing spots and much more.

Guest Speaker: Judy MacKeigan is currently serving as the historian/archivist for Cleveland Metroparks. She joined the park system in 2010 while completing her MA in History from Cleveland State University. Judy has the joy and privilege of researching, compiling and sharing the history of Cleveland Metroparks and also the local history of the communities in the Metroparks district. She was lead author and chief editor of the book *The 100 Year Trail: A Centennial Celebration of Cleveland Metroparks*, and she serves on the Centennial Celebration steering committee.
