Warren Remein was voted in as the newest member of Bay Village Kiwanis. The vote was unanimous. Many good things were said about Warren. He is a welcome addition to the Club. Pat M made a motion to fund the Bay High School First Robotics team \$500 to aid in purchasing tools and equipment necessary to continue work on their robot. The funding level was increased to \$750 and the vote was unanimous. Mr. Clifford the Bay High School Physics teacher and organizer of the Bay Village High School Robotics team received the funds this past week and thanked us for the donation. The meeting was adjourned and the remainder of the evening was spent in lively conversation while enjoying half priced appetizers. Several members of other Kiwanis Clubs joined us for the event.

President Foster M. provided a King Cake for the Mardi Gras dessert. Hundreds of thousands of King Cakes are eaten in [New Orleans](#) during the Carnival season. The cake often has a small plastic baby (to represent the [Baby Jesus](#)) inside or underneath; and the person who gets the piece of cake with the trinket has various privileges and obligations. The season for king cake extends from the end of the Twelve Days of Christmas ([Twelfth Night](#) and Epiphany Day), up until the end of [Shrovetide](#): Mardi Gras, "Fat Tuesday," or Shrove Tuesday; the day before the start of [Lent](#). Ed C. was served the piece containing the baby with the resultant obligation of organizing the party next year.
